Dear Parents or Guardians,

We are delighted to inform you that we are planning to take next year's Year 6 pupils (current year 5) on a residential course to Manor Adventure Activity Centre in Craven Arms, Shropshire between **Monday, 16<sup>th</sup> September – Friday 20<sup>th</sup> September 2019**.

As you are aware, residential courses organised by the school are an optional but invaluable part of the National Curriculum. Children benefit enormously from the experience, both educationally and socially and we feel certain that the course this year will prove to be enjoyable and worthwhile. We have chosen to take the whole of Year 6 at the beginning of the school year as it is felt that this shared experience will encourage cohesion within the group and build a sense of team spirit that will be of benefit in the year to come.

Manor Adventure is a residential school that follows a rewarding educational programme combined with exciting outdoor and indoor activities all taking place in a controlled environment. So that you and your child can be better informed about the experience at Manor Adventure, we would like to invite you both to a meeting on **Monday, 1<sup>st</sup> April at 3:30pm** in the school hall, where you will meet the staff accompanying your child and have the chance to see for yourselves the opportunities and experiences that Manor Adventure can provide. If you do have children at the Infant school, please make alternative arrangements for their collection so that you can attend the meeting. It is best that other siblings do not attend as there will already be a large number of pupils and parents attending this important meeting. Please speak to your child's teacher at collection time if you have any queries or via the homework diary.

The total cost of the residential trip will be approximately **£305** depending on final numbers. In order for the visit to proceed and to secure your child's place, we will require your consent and a **non-refundable deposit of £50 between Monday 1<sup>st</sup> April and Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2019, via ParentPay. (Please note the system will not accept payments before 1<sup>st</sup> April)**. Once final numbers have been confirmed, you will be advised of the balance due, which will need to be paid by Monday 8th July, (which can be paid in instalments).
