

Recommended Kit List for Manor Adventure Visit

This is the recommended Packing List for the children who are going to Manor Adventure in September. Please note that children may not be able to take part in certain activities if they are not appropriately dressed.

Luggage: Please restrict this to one case, plus one piece of hand luggage (e.g. small rucksack).
Bedding: Sleeping bag & pillow case
Bin liner: For storing dirty clothes

Indoor Clothes

T-shirts, trousers / jogging bottoms, jumpers / sweatshirts, underwear, toiletries, towels (x2) and nightwear.

Outdoor Clothes

Pullovers: Warm jumpers / sweatshirts / fleece jacket.
Trousers: Any thick woven fabric or jogging bottoms. Denim jeans are not suitable for many of the outdoor activities.

It is advisable that the children bring the following footwear:

- Indoor shoes (trainers, pumps etc);
- Sturdy outdoor footwear (walking boots, walking trainers, trainers that can get muddy);
- Wellies & wellie socks (only permitted for 'Maze');
- Beach shoes, old trainers or pumps for canoeing and kayaking. (Plan for these only to be worn for this activity. These must be 'closed' shoes);
- Slippers (optional).

Waterproof: A light cagoule is best – this can be stowed in a rucksack if not needed. Waterproof trousers may also be useful if you have them.

Hat / gloves/torch: We may be doing the night walk and it gets very cold. A torch is necessary for this activity.

Optional: Hair dryer, disposable camera (named). Please note – these items are optional and are your child's responsibility.

It is also a requirement that children with long hair are able to tie it back for the activity sessions. Please provide hair clips / hair bands as appropriate. Children may not be able to participate in some activities if not appropriately dressed.

Please ensure that children have a few spare sets of clothes (i.e. more than one set of clothes for each day. They will get wet/muddy on some activities and will need to change during the day).

Children may bring notepads, magazines or card games to play on the journey. Again, these are optional and are your child's responsibility.

We strongly advise that **all** children bring a lip salve. Open to the elements, children can suffer from dry and chapped lips. Please ensure that this is also named. (We do not permit sharing of lip salves due to hygiene.)

Clothing is dried in communal drying rooms. PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL CLOTHING, SHOES AND EQUIPMENT IS CLEARLY NAMED!

Children will have copies of Manor Adventure's *Clothing – What to wear on sessions* sheet available in their rooms to help them dress appropriately.

Children should **NOT** bring:

- Mobile Phones
- Expensive cameras (disposable only)
- Electronic games
- Ipods/ipads
- Jewellery (no earrings)
- Expensive or favourite clothes / shoes
