

Nursery - Ideas for learning from home.

1 Read a story every day to your child.

Get the child to discuss what is happening at the 'beginning', 'middle' and 'end' of the story.

Can your child name the characters of the story and the setting (where it takes place)?

Look out for and discuss rhyming words.

Are there any words in the story that start with the same sound as their name? Your name etc.?

2 Maths

Using some objects, count them, write the number down for them.

What is one more and one less than the number?

Practically add two sets of objects together (total under 10)

Which set has more/most, least, less/fewest?
