



Dear Year 6 parents,

Due to the temporary closure of our school, we have set out below mandatory homework and projects for Year 6 pupils during this time. This will support the teaching and learning that your child has done so far in this important academic year. So as not to lose momentum, we have detailed the areas of maths and English for your child to complete during this temporary closure period.

As you are aware, each pupil has a set of **CGP maths and English books** and we have been setting particular pages for your children to complete. As of now, please get your children to routinely complete pages on all the following areas so that they revise and consolidate all the learning they have done so far this year. In your Parents' Evening feedback sheets, we listed targets for Maths and English specifically for your child therefore do also select the relevant pages within the CGP books for your child to complete as consolidation of their learning during lessons.

### CGP ENGLISH

- **SPELLING:** Section 1: word patterns, Section 2: word beginnings. Section 3: word endings. Section 4: confusing words
- **GRAMMAR:** Section 1: Types of words, Section 2: Clauses, phrases and sentences. Section 3: conjunctions and prepositions. Section 4: sentence structure and tense. Section 5: Writing style. Section 6: Making and choosing words.
- **PUNCTUATION:** Section 1: Basic punctuation, Section 2: Apostrophes and inverted commas. Section 3: commas. Section 4: Brackets, dashes and hyphens. Section 5: colons and semi-colons. Section 6: mixed practice.

### CGP MATHS

- **ARITHMETIC:** Section 1: Whole numbers, Section 2: Decimals Section 3: Fractions
- **NUMBER, RATIO, ALGEBRA:** Section 1: Number & Ratio, Section 2: Calculations, Section 3: problem solving.
- **GEOMETRY, MEASURE, STATISTICS:** Section 1: Geometry, Section 2: Measurement and Section 3: Statistics (tables/charts/graphs)



All the spelling lists that they have learnt from September are now open on the Spelling Shed and usable. There are super activities on this website that your child can go on to reinforce the spelling rule.

Please also ensure your child logs into **Times Table Rock Stars** to consolidate and further their mental agility with numbers. All the pupils log in details are up to date and can be found in the front of their Homework diary.
