



W/C 15.06.2020: Feelings

Age Range: EYFS Nursery

Weekly Reading & Phonics Tasks

Continue reading and discussing a book each day. Characters, setting etc.

Hear and say initial sounds so that your child can recognise the different sounds and blend them together.

Segment words into simple sounds and blend them together. d-o-g, c-a-t etc. Extend to write the initial sound letter on the whiteboard.

Weekly Writing Tasks

Continue to practice writing their name, with a good pencil grip and correct formation of the letters, also include their surname.

Linking sounds to letters, naming and sounding the letters of the alphabet
Show the children the correct way to form the letter. Ask do you know what this letter is? What sound does it make? Can you think of any words beginning with a?
Get the children to copy you write 'a' in the air. Then give each child a different colour and get them to correctly write over the letter. Continuing practising on a whiteboard (if you have one alternatively use paper).

Weekly Maths Tasks

Counting 1 to 1 and recognise numerals to 10.

Make circles for each number and get your child to find the right amount of items to put in each circle. Make sure they check they have the correct amount using 1 to 1 counting. Extend by getting your child to practise writing the numbers.





Learning Project – Feelings

Talk to your child about feelings. Identify different feelings and ask your child if they can remember when they have experienced a particular feeling. Explain that everyone has feelings and that we experience different feelings at different times. Also get your child to understand there is no right or wrong way to feel.

Make emotions mask using paper plates, try to make them as detailed as possible.

Alternatively they can make features using emotions using playdough (please see the pictures attached to guide you).
