Weekly Reading & Phonics Tasks

Reading

Open your **2Do in Purple Mash** and read the fourth chapter of **Ned and the Jungle Creatures**. You could take it in turns with an adult to read.

Then open your **2Do Chapter 4 Quiz** and complete.

In this chapter the author writes: '*Ned sat in class miserably*'. What does 'miserably' mean? Why was Ned 'miserable'? Can you think of any other words that mean the same as 'miserable'?

Watch the video for **ey** (ee, ai) to learn the two different pronunciations for **ey** as in 'donkey' and 'prey'. Complete the two activities.

Open your **2Do in Purple Mash** and revisit the fourth chapter of **Ned and the Jungle Creatures**. Open your **2Do Chapter 4 Missing Words** and complete.

When you are re-reading this chapter, can you find the word that means the same as 'vanished'?


