### Weekly Reading & Phonics Tasks

#### Day 1

##### Phonics

Access the Espresso site. [Click here](#) to log on.

Click on the Key Stage 1 tab at the top and find the English, Phonics section. Enter the Sal's phonics, Phase 5 alternative spellings.

Watch the video for **air** (ere, ear, are). Today we'll be focusing on the **are** spelling making the 'air' sound as in 'scare'.

Share the following words with your child: *bare, care, dare, glare, hare, rare, scare, share, spare, stare, square.*

Place the words around the house and have a word hunt! Once a word has been discovered and read out loud, ask your child to write it down, draw a picture and use it in a sentence.

##### Reading

Open your **2Do in Purple Mash** and read the third chapter of **Ned and the Jungle Creatures**. You could take it in turns with an adult to read.

Then open your **2Do Chapter 3 Quiz** and complete.

Talk with your grown up about what your favourite part of this chapter was and why.

#### Day 2

##### Phonics


Access the Espresso site (details above).

Click on the Key Stage 1 tab at the top and find the English, Phonics section. Enter the Sal's phonics, Phase 5 alternative spellings.

Revisit the video for **air** (ere, ear, are). Today we'll be focusing on the **ear** spelling making the 'air' sound as in 'wear'.

Read the following words with your child: *bear, pear, wear, tear, swear* and show the pictures below.

Using the **ear** spelling and their phonic knowledge, without looking at the spellings, ask your child to write the matching word for each picture. Can they write a sentence for each picture too?



**Reading**

Open your **2Do in Purple Mash** and revisit the third chapter of **Ned and the Jungle Creatures**. Open your **2Do Chapter 3 Missing Words** and complete.

What do you think is going to happen next in the story? You could write your prediction down and save it for next week to see if you were right!

**Day 3**

**Phonics**

Access the Espresso site (details above).

Click on the Key Stage 1 tab at the top and find the English, Phonics section. Enter the Sal's phonics, Phase 5 alternative spellings.

Revisit the video for **air** (ere, ear, are). Today we'll be focusing on all the different ways of spelling the 'air' sound, including **ere** making the 'air' sound as in 'there'.

Now that you have learnt the different ways to spell the 'air' sound, you can complete the two activities on Espresso if you would like, sorting and reading words with the different spellings of the 'air' sound.

Why not play some games on [Phonics Play](#) afterwards? We like playing [Cheeky Chimps](#) to practise alternative pronunciations (use 'march20' and 'home' to access).

**Reading**

Open your **2Do in Purple Mash** and revisit the third chapter of **Ned and the Jungle Creatures**. Open your **2Do Chapter 3 Joining Words** and complete.

Choose a one of your favourite story books and read it with your grown up – how many times has the author used the word **said**? What words could the author have used instead of **said**?

Use coins to make a rubbing picture. You could calculate the total value of your picture.




Or look at the dates on your coins.
